Transfer Applicants

25 years of age or older at the start of your first term and have not previously attended any college

- Schedule a mandatory interview with a Bloomfield College admission counselor.

Test - Optional Policy

Bloomfield College allows those applying for admission the option of not submitting standardized test scores, except in select circumstances. Students who opt out of submitting SAT/ACT scores will be evaluated on their high school grade point average, curriculum, recommendations, and writing skills, among other achievements. - Earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above
 - Attained the minimum score set by the New Jersey Department of Education on the Praxis Core Academic Skills Battery for Educators or SAT/ACT Exam
 - Earned a grade of C or better in the following courses: MTH 130 and MTH 140, 141, 160 or 161, and WRT 106 and WRT 107, EDC 202, EDC 210, EDC 217, EDC 316

Nursing

Students may apply to the program once they have:

- Sophomore standing
- Earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above
- Completed a highly-selective pre-entry standardized examination
- Earned a grade of C or better in the following courses: WRT 105 or WRT 106, WRT 107, MTH 130, MTH 140 or MTH 141, BIO 205, BIO 206, and NUR 105

Pre-Medical Studies

Students who are interested in pursuing careers such as medicine, dentistry, and physical therapy should consult with the Pre-Professional Coordinator in the Division of Natural Sciences and Mathematics for guidance about selecting a major.

BS/MS Accounting (5-year program)

Students may apply to the program once they have:

- Overall cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above
- Earned a grade of B or above in ACC 201 and ACC 204
