Tuition Refund

If a student files a written notice of withdrawal with the Registrar's Office according to the schedule below, tuition only will be refunded as follows:

1st week	01/13/22 - 01/19/22	100% of tuition
2nd week	01/20/22 - 01/26/22	100% of tuition
3rd week	01/27/22 - 02/02/22	75% of tuition
4th week	02/03/22 - 02/09/22	50% of tuition
5th week	02/10/22 and after	0% of tuition

After the fourth week of the semester, no refund of tuition will be made if the student withdraws.

In the event of withdrawal, all fees, bookstore charges and room fees will be billed at 100%. The board fee is prorated. See the College Catalog for the Financial Aid refund policy.

\*Bill Settlement and Payments

- ✔ We accept cash, checks, VISA, MasterCard, AMEX and Discover. Credit card payments can be accepted at the Office of Student Financial Services by telephone or by following the link on Web Advisor for TouchNet if paying the balance due in full.
- ✔ Students should meet with an Office of Student Financial Services counselor if financial aid documents are missing or have questions pertaining to their award package.
- ✔ Bill Settlement will be given to students who complete one of the following options:  
 Pay their balance due in full, or  
 Set up an approved payment plan using CashNet's Payment Plan, or  
 Receive enough financial aid to cover their entire bill (the Office of Student Financial Services will make this determination).
- ✔ Students must receive bill settlement from the Office of Student Financial Services by the January 7, 2022 deadline in order to avoid a \$100 fee
