The Frances M. McLaughlin Division of Nursing at Bloomfield College invites applications for a tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor of Nursing for Spring 2020 semester. This requires experience as a nurse educator (CNE certification preferred). Experience in Adult Health Nursing (medical/surgical, nursing research) and experience teaching in BSN programs preferred. Qualified applicants must hold a Master's degree in Nursing as the minimal requirement. A terminal degree is preferred and applicants enrolled in courses toward a terminal degree are considered first. Current clinical practice is also expected. Nurse Practitioners holding a minimum of Master's degree in Nursing and enrolled in a doctoral program are encouraged to apply; New Jersey license required.

Applicants must electronically submit (PDF format preferred) a letter of application, *curriculum vitae*, and three letters of recommendation with contact information (submitted directly from the person writing the letter) to nursing_search@bloomfield.edu. Official graduate transcripts will be required of applicants accepted for an interview. (Electronic submissions only, no phone calls please). Search is open until filled.
