The faculty member will be expected to lead development of a new undergraduate program curriculum in supply chain management. The successful candidate should have a Ph.D. or D.B.A with some higher education teaching experience. Preference will be given to candidates with a discipline background in operations, logistics, supply chain management or related areas. Candidates must have a strong commitment to teaching and innovation, and be available for service to the division and school. The appointment requires flexibility in teaching day/evening classes and in-person/online teaching.
